C., its successors and assigns, forever:

ALL of the lands or interest in lands, property rights or easements, of whatsoever nature, kind and description, with all buildings and improvements thereon, owned by the Grantor and lying within the borders of the State of South Carolina, and located in, and in the vicinity of North Saluda River Watershed, specifically including, but not limited, to the following:

(1) That tract of land in Glassy Mountain Township on both sides of Jamison's Mill Creek and Bellew's Mill Creek, waters of South Pacolet River, containing 72 acres, more or less, and being described by metes and bounds, as follows:

BEGINNING on a locust near a large rock and running thence S. 75 W., 17.50 chains to a stake X on Southwest face of Big Rock in Southeast slope of Hogback Mountain; thence S.  $31\frac{1}{2}$  W. (this line running along impassable cliffs of rock) 31.00 chains to a hickory; thence N. 60 E., 25.00 chains to a poplar stump on line of fence; thence N. 5 W., 14.00 chains to a chestnut oak stump; thence N. 24 E., 21.00 chains to the beginning corner, containing seventy-two (72) acres, more or less.
