

ENOW ALL LIEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That I, Annie II. Kesler, of the City of Winston-salem, Forsyth County, State of Morth Carolina, in consideration of the love and affection I have for my sister, Carolyn L. Hercer, the grantee herein, and in further consideration of the sum of One (1.00) Dollar to me (the grantor) in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by said Carolyn L. Mercer (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Carolyn II. Hercer, all my right, title and interest (the same being an undivided one-half interest), of, in and to the following described real estate, to-wit:

All that parcel, piece or lot of land, together with the fiveroom tenant duelling thereon, situate in or near the City of Greenville, in Farker District, Greenville County, South Carolina, said lot
being designated as Lot No. 13 on plat made by C. L. Furman, Engineer,
and having a front upon Anderson Street of fifty (50) feet; a depth along line of Lot No. 12 (now conveyed to Susie T. Douglas) a distance
of one hundred thirty (130) feet, more or less, with a width in the
rear along line of Right-of-Nay of Greenville D. Columbia Railway Conpany of forty-five and one-half (45-1/2) feet, more or less; and a
depth along line of Lot No. 14 of one hundred thirty (130) feet;
bounded on the front by said Anderson Street, on the northeastern
side by Lot No. 12, now of Nrs. Susie M. Douglas; on the rear by Rightof-Nay of said Greenville & Columbia Railway Company; and on the other
side by Lot No. 14.

Lot No. 13 is one of two lots of land (Nos. 12 and 13), designated as house Nos. 1235 and 1235 Anderson Street, Greenville, South Carolina, conveyed to Julia G. Milliams by J. L. Fortner, Individually and as Executor and Trustee of Ora S. Fortner, deceased, by deed of date 25th day of January, 1932, recorded in office of Register of Nesne Conveyance for Greenville County, S. C., in Deed Book 144, page 37.
