All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, Gantt Township, being known and designated as Lot No. 50 of a subdivision known as South Forest Estates according to a plat thereof prepared by Pickell & Pickell, Engineers, on August 29, 1955, and recorded in the R.
