CONTRACT OF SALE AND PURCHASE

THIS CONTRACT made this 24th day of May, 1957 by and between Gladys Boyd Brooks and Clarence M. Brooks, Jr., here-inafter referred to as Sellers and Minnie S. Crane, hereinafter referred to as Purchaser,

WITNESSETH:

That the Sellers agree to sell and the Purchaser agrees to purchase the property hereinafter described for the sum of Twenty Thousand (\$20,000.00) Dollars, to be paid as follows:

The sum of \$500.00 at the time of the execution of this agreement, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, and the balance of \$19,500.00 upon delivery of the deed at the closing.

The property to be conveyed by the Sellers to the Purchaser is described as follows:

All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Green-ville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, on the West side of North Main Street, in the City of Greenville, State of South Carolina, being shown as Lot No. 6 of Block "B" on plat of Northgate Subdivision, revised by R. E. Dalton, May 1939, and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Green-ville County in Plat Book "M" at page 13, and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the West side of North Main Street, at joint corner of Lots 5 and 6 of Block "B", and running thence with the line of Lot No. 5, N. 89-55 W. 187 feet to iron pin in rear line of Lot No. 19; thence with the rear line of Lots Nos. 18 and 19, in a Northerly direction 70 feet to an iron pin, corner of Lot No. 7; thence with the line of Lot No. 7, S. 89-55 E. 191.6 feet to an iron pin on the West side of North Main Street; thence with the West side of North Main Street, S. 4-46 W. 70 feet to the beginning corner.
