

W. Dalton, the following metes and bounds, courses and distances, to-wit:

Beginning at an iron pin on the south side of Croft Street, the joint front w. 200 feet to an iron pin on the northern side of a 16 ft. alley; thence with the northern side of a 16 ft. alley; thence with the northern side of said Alley, N. 83-13 W. 54.375 feet to an iron pin; thence with a new line through lot No. 33, N. 1-41 E. 200 feet to a point (drill hole) on the south side of Croft Street; thence with the south side of said Croft Street S. 83-13 E. 54.375 feet to the beginning corner.
