That I, Elizabeth Waldrop Gosnell, in consideration of the sum of Four Hundred & no/100 (\$400.00) - - DOLLARS,

to the grantor(s) in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by the grantee(s) (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said

Paul Eugene McClure, his heirs and assigns, all my right, title, interest and estate in and to all that piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in the County of Greenville, South Carolina, in Glassy Mountain Township, and lying on a branch of Vaughn's Creek waters of North Pacolet River, and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at a stone pile; thence North 20-1/2 W. 4.32 chains to a stake in place of Spanish Oak; thence North 64-1/6 W., 20.90 to a Sourwood X 30 m.; thence due South 17.00 chains to a Hickory X 30 m.; thence along an old road South 66-3/8 E., 9.85 chains in road; thence North 88-1/3 E., 2.26 chains; thence North 61-5/8 E., 1.31 chains to stake in road; thence North 45-1/2 E., 4.89 chains to a small Persimmon X 3n.m. at corner old field; thence North 81 E., 7.53 chains to a stake 7 lks. South of a Hickory; thence North 36-1/4 W., 23 lks. to the Beginning, containing 25-1/2 acres, more or less.
