POWER OF ATTORNEY

Know all men by these presents that I, Elliott P. Cleveland of Marietta, South Carolina, do appoint J. Norwood Cleveland of Marietta, South Carolina, my true and lawful attorney for me, and in my name, place and stead, to grant, bargain, sell and mortgage any and all real or personal property of which I am now possessed or have any interest in or which I may hereafter acquire located in these United States of America, for such price and on such terms and to such person or persons as he, my said attorney, shall deem fit and proper, and also for me, and in my name and as my act and deed to sign, execute, acknowledge and deliver such contract or contracts for the sale thereof, or any part thereof; also to sign, execute, acknowledge and deliver deed or deeds, either with or without covenants of warranty, and conveyance or conveyances for the absolute sale or disposal thereof or any part thereof with such clause or clauses, covenant or covenants to be therein contained as my said attorney shall deem fit and proper; also to sign, execute, acknowledge and deliver mortgage or mortgages conveying any or all of the aforesaid premises to secure the payment of such sum or sums as my said attorney may deem fit and proper to borrow; also to sign, execute and deliver for me, and in my name, place and stead notes and any and all other evidences of indebtedness that he, my said attorney, shall deem fit and proper, and to buy and sell any bonds, stocks and other securities which my said attorney shall deem fit and proper; also to collect and receive any and all monies and property that may be due me, and to execute receipts, releases and satisfactions therefor; also to execute, deliver and cash checks drawn on any bank deposit standing in my name, and to invest, reinvest and pay out any money belonging to me which may come into his hands, hereby ratifying and confirming all such contracts, deeds, conveyances, bargains, sales and all other acts that my said attorney may do
