NOW, THEREFORE, KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, that I, Mabel Virginia Cagle, in consideration of the premises and the sum of One Dollar to me paid at and before the sealing of these presents by Frances S. Cagle (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) and the love and affection for the grantee herein, and other good and valuable consideration, have granted, bargained, sold and released and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Frances S. Cagle, her heirs and assigns, forever all interest acquired by me under the provisions of that certain instrument of conveyance from J. W. Cagle unto me on May 7, 1956 and filed and entered of record in the office of the County Auditor for Greenville County, South Carolina on May 23, 1956, in Book "Q" at page 174, and filed for record in the office of the RMC for Greenville County, South Carolina, at 9:00 o'clock A.M., May 23, 1956, and recorded in Deed Book 553 at page 163 in and to the property inherited by the said J. W. Cagle under the provisions of the last will and testament of Jacob W. Cagle.

It is the intention of the grantor herein, Mabel Virginia Cagle, to convey unto the grantee herein, Frances S. Cagle, only that interest acquired by her in the deed hereinabove referred to from J. W. Cagle, and it is the intention of the grantor herein to convey unto the grantee no interest whatsoever in and to the estate of the said Jacob W. Cagle inherited by the said Mabel Virginia Cagle in her own right, but to convey unto the grantee only that interest conveyed unto her by J. W. Cagle.
