Wood, his heirs and assigns:

All that piece, parcel or lot of land lying in Butler Township, lying situate near the City of Greenville, County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, and known and designated as Lot #24, on the western side of Canter Drive, part of a subdivision known as Laurel Heights, and being more particularly described according to Plat recorded in the R.
