All that piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville being known and designated as Lot No. 9 of a subdivision known as Hutton Court as shown on a plat thereof being recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book NN at Page 101 and having according to a more recent survey prepared for Charles F. McWhorter by R. B. Bruce, R.L.S. dated September 8, 1958, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:
