WHEREAS, it is the desire of all of the above named contributors, as well as any who may contribute thereto in the future, that the Trust to be created be permanent and that it provide funds for the perpetual care of the White Oak Cemetery which is to include all areas shown in White Oak Cemetery proper, as well as the Waddell Section and the Green Section, all of which are shown on Plat recorded in Plat Book H, at page 261, R.M.C. Office for Greenville County;

THEREFORE, we, W. S. Bradley, as Successor Trustee to Carey Cemetery Trust, W. S. Bradley, Ruth G. Shealy, Lois B. Green, T. A. McCarter (for McCarter family), Lula K. Green, Anne E. Bradley and Eula Bradley, do hereby create a Trust Fund to be known as the White Oak Cemetery Trust by paying over to the South Carolina National Bank, of Greenville, S. C., the sums hereinabove mentioned and set opposite our names for the following uses and purposes and subject to the following trust:

- 1. With full power and authority in and to said
  Trustee to invest and keep invested the proceeds of said Trust,
  which is to include all sums paid over by the Trustors, all
  sums made available by devise in the future, as well as the
  proceeds from the sale or sales of cemetery lots, with full
  power to change and vary investments from time to time in its
  absolute discretion.
- 2. To employ a person or persons at all times in the future to perform all services incident to or necessary to maintain the White Oak Cemetery as hereinabove specified in good condition at all times.
- 3. To use so much of the net income arising from said

  Trust Fund as may be necessary for the payment of all services
