All my right, title and interest in and to All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville

Township, Greenville County, State

of South Carolina, with the buildings and improvements thereon, lying and being on the southeasterly side of Green Avenue, in the City of Greenville, adjoining lots now or formerly belonging to John Arnett, Homer Jones and A. C. Davis, and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on Green Avenue (Arnett's corner), and running with Arnett's line one hundred and six (106) feet to a stake on A. C. Davis' line; thence with Davis line fifty (50) feet to a stake; thence with Davis line one hundred and six (106) feet to a stake on Green Avenue; thence with Green Avenue fifty (50) feet, more or less, to the beginning corner.
