FIRST: That their names and residences are as above given.

SECOND: That the name of the proposed corporation is HOPE HAVEN HOSPITAL, INC.

THIRD: That the principal place of business is TRAVELERS REST, S. C.

FOURTH: That the general nature of the business which it is proposed to do is small hospital for the treatment and care of alcoholics.
