

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Chick Springs Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, in the City of Greer, School District #285, and also known as No. 215 West Poinsett Street, on the south side of said Poinsett Street, and as shown by plat thereof prepared by H. S. Brockman, Surveyor, February 18th, 1955, as having the following courses and distances, to-wit:-

Beginning at an iron pin at or near the corner of the home lot of grantor on the south side of Poinsett Street, and runs thence S 17-59 W two
