BRUCE (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said P. L. BRUCE, NORA B. BRUCE and T. S. BRUCE, their heirs and assigns, forever:

ALL that certain piece, parcel or lot of land with the buildings and improvements thereon, situate on the Southwest side of Laurel Street in Greenville Township, Greenville County, South Carolina, known and designated as Lot No. 13 on plat of property of G.D. Oxner made by R. E. Dalton, April 1923, and having, according to said plat, which is recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville County, S.C. in Plat Book G, at page 42, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:
