All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, near the City of Greenville, on the northern side of Green Avenue Extension (formerly Melrose Avenue), known and designated as Lot No. 16, Block A, on plat of Melrose Land Company, plat recorded in Plat Book A, page 157, and being more particularly described as follows:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the northern side of Green Avenue Extension (formerly Melrose Avenue), corner of Lot No. 15, and running thence with line of said lot in a northwesterly direction 188 feet to an iron pin on the right-of-way of the G. and C. Railway; thence with said right-of-way as a line in a northwesterly direction 51 feet, more or less, to an iron pin, corner of Lot No. 17; thence with line of said lot in a southeasterly direction 195.4 feet to an iron pin on Green Avenue Extension; thence with the northern side of Green Avenue Extension, in an easterly direction, 50 feet to the beginning corner; being the same conveyed to the grantor by Revalee Cartee by deed dated November 16, 1942 and recorded in the R.
