AGREEMENT

COUNTY OF GREENVILLE

This Agreement entered into by and between Mrs. Nora Case McMahon and Mrs. Bertha C. Cowan, hereinafter referred to as McMahon and Cowan respectively this 15th day of July, 1957,

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, McMahon is the owner of one 28 foot Prairie Schooner House Trailor which she purchased from Ridley Trailor Sales, Inc. on July 15, 1957, and

WHEREAS, Cowan is the owner of a certain lot of land situate at 29 West Avenue just outside the City of Greenville, South Carolina,

NOW, THEREFORE, for and in consideration of this writing the parties hereto agree as follows:

- 1. McMahon agrees to give said trailor to Cowan at the time of her death. In the event Cowan should predecease McMahon, then said trailor is to go to Cowan's son, Frank James Fowler, at the time of McMahon's death. In the event McMahon does not leave a will ratifying her intent herein expressed, the same shall be considered as though she made a will.
- 2. In consideration for number 1 above Cowan agrees that McMahon shall have the right to park her trailor on Cowan's lot above described as long as the same is owned by Cowan and during said time McMahon shall have the right to tap on to Cowan's light and water connection free of charge. That is to say, McMahon shall have the right to receive all water and electricity necessary for her use in said trailor free of charge.
- 3. In the event Cowan should sell her said property. McMahon shall have the right to remove her trailor from said lot and transport the same anywhere she may direct.
