GENERAL POWER OF ATTORNEY

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS THAT I, Agnes S. Mitchell of the State and County aforesaid, being desirous of appointing an attorney-in-fact to act for me and in my stead on all matters in which I may have an interest, do hereby nominate, constitute and appoint Roy W. Cureton of the State and County aforesaid, my true and lawful attorney-in-fact with full power to pledge, mortgage, sell, transfer, assign, exchange, or otherwise dispose of any or all of my property, whether real, personal or mixed, at such prices and under such terms and conditions as she may deem proper, and to execute and deliver good and sufficient instruments for the accomplishment thereof; to collect, sue upon, compromise or otherwise adjust any and all claims, debts, bequests, or devises in which I now or may hereafter have an interest; to pay, compromise, or otherwise discharge and secure releases from any obligations or claims against me; to deposit in my name and for my account with any bank, banker or trust company any checks or other evidences of indebtedness which may come to her hands as such attorney; and all monies, bills of exchange, drafts, promissory notes and other securities for money payable or belonging to me, and for that purpose to sign my name and endorse the same for deposit or collection, and from time to time, to withdraw any and all monies deposited with any bank, banker, trust company, or other depository, now or hereafter having any monies belonging to me, and for that purpose to draw checks in my name.

FURTHER, I DO AUTHORIZE AND EMPOWER MY ATTORNEY IN FACT to perform all necessary acts in the execution of the aforesaid authorization, and I do hereby declare that the powers herein granted to my aforesaid attorney-in-fact shall not be construed as limited to those matters hereinabove specifically set forth, but rather shall be construed to broadly include and embrace full and unlimited power and authority to do and perform, on my behalf and in my place and stead and with equal validity, any and all other lawful acts or things which I could do if personally present; hereby ratifying and confirming whatsoever my said attorney shall and may do, by virtue hereof, in the premises.

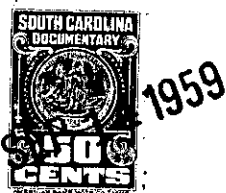

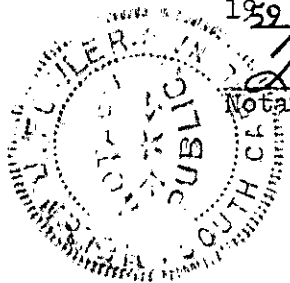
