

All that certain piece, parcel or tract of land being, lying, and situate on the north side of the Pelham Road (a state highway) in Greenville County, South Carolina, containing 1.61 acres, more or less, and being bounded on the north by other property of the grantor, on theeast by M. M. McJunkin, on the south by the Pelham Road, and on the west by other property of the grant , and being described by metes and bounds in accordance with a plat by J.
