ll. It is understood that all lots shown on said Plat are to be conveyed subject to an easement of 2-1/2 feet for drainage on each side line and back line of said lots should the same become necessary for drainage; provided, however, if a purchaser of any of said lots shall construct a house on two lots so that the house will cover the dividing line of said lots, said easement shall cease to be effective on that particular lot, as there will be no necessity therefor.

12. The owner reserves the right to permit the installation of utilities, such as water, sewarage or electric power lines along the street adjacent to said lots without compensation to the purchasers of the several lots.

These covenants are to run with the land, and shall be binding upon all persons owning any of said lots during the period of their application. If the parties hereto, or any of them, their Heirs or Assigns, shall violate or attempt to violate any of the above covenants, it shall be lawful for any other person or persons owning any of the lots shown on said Plat to prosecute any proceedings at law against the person or persons violating or attempting to violate any such covenants, either to prevent him or them from so doing or to recover damages for such violation.
