Houston died testate and by his will which is on file in the Office of the Probate Court for Greenville County, S.C. in Apartment 540, File 1, he devised his interest in the above described property to his wife, Mary Good Houston. Thereafter, Mary Good Houston died testate August 7, 1958 and by her will which is on file in Apartment 687, File 21, Office of the Probate Court for Greenville County, S.C., she devised her interest in the said property to the grantors, Ella Houston Zachery and Mary Houston Merritt, her daughters. William Henry Houston subsequently died on October 18, 1943 and by his will which is on file in the Office of the Probate Court for Greenville County, S.C. in Apartment 470, File 14, he devised his interest in the above property to the First National Bank of Greenville as Trustee, giving said Trustee full power to sell and convey and thereafter, The South Carolina National Bank of Charleston became successor Trustee under said will by merger and consolidation with the said First National Bank of Greenville, S.C.
