

Sitton, made by Piedmont Engineering Service dated April 13, 1955 and recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville County in Plat Book II, page 127 and having the following metes and bounds:

BEGINNING at a point on the Eastern side of S. C.Highway No. 291, said point being the joint front corner of Lots 3 and 4 according to said plat and running thence South 88-15 East 183.77 feet to a point on the service alley; thence North 0-43 East 40.02 feet to a point, said point being the joint rear corner of land previously conveyed by Earle M. Lineberger and E. M. Paul, Jr.; running thence along the line of land previously conveyed by Earle M. Lineberger and E. M. Paul, Jr., North 88-15 West 182.01 feet to a point on the East side of S. C. Highway No. 291; running thence with said highway, South 1-45 West 40 feet to an iron pin, the point of beginning.
