E. Broadnax, his heirs and assigns:

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being on the northwestern side of Bristol Drive, near the City of Greenville, County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, of the property of Palmetto Developers, Inc., and known and designated as Lot #11, as shown on plat made by Dalton & Neves, June 1957, and recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book KK, at Page 131, and according to said plat having the following metes and bounds:
