

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I, William M. Shields, of Laurens County,

in the State aforesaid for and

in consideration of the

sum of Seven Thousand, Six hundred twenty-six and 3/100 (\$7,626.03) Dollars, and the assumption of mortgage indebtedness, to re in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by MTLLS STEELE, of Greenville, in the County of Greenville,

in the State aforesaid (receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said MILLS STELLE

County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, known and designated as Lot No. 31 on plat of property of Estate of D.T. Smith made by Dalton & Neves, Engineers, May, 1935, recorded in Plat Book H. page 279 of the RMC office for Greenville County, South Carolina, and having according to said plat the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

Beginning at a stake on the south side of Tallulah Drive 300 feet west from Ioka Street, at corner of Lot No. 33, and running thence with the line of said lot S25-20 E. 200 ft. to a stake at corner of Lot No. 32; thence with line of said lot S64-40 W. 100 ft. to stake at corner of Lot No. 29; thence with the line of said lot N25-20 W. 200 ft. to a stake on Tallulah Drive; thence with the southern corner of Tallulah Drive N64-40 E. 100 ft. to the beginning corner.

The lot of land above described and hereby conveyed is the same property conveyed to the grantor, William ". Shields by M.7. Proffitt by deed dated Aurust 30,1960 recorded in Deed Book 658 at page 31, office of the RMC for Greenville County, South Carolina.

As a part of the consideration for this deed the grantee herein specifically assumes the rayment of a certain real estate note and mortgage covering the premises hereinabove described given by the grantor to Fidelity Savings & Loan Association, Greenville, S.C. on which there is a balance due of \$14,373.97.
