RELEASE OF RESTRICTIONS

WHEREAS in Deed from June W. Collinson, John Milton Williams, Jr., and Viola D. Hodgens, to Walter Frank Conners and Catherine Fintch Conners, recorded July 7, 1947, in Deed Volume 314 at page 403, the following building restrictions and restrictive covenants were placed on the property conveyed therein:

"It is understood and agreed that the above described property shall be used for residential purposes only and that no residence shall be erected thereon the cost of which shall be less than \$10,000.00. No building shall be erected on said property for the conduct of business and no business of any character whatsoever shall be conducted on said property or therefrom. It is intended and agreed that these restrictions or covenants shall run with the land and that the same constitute part consideration for this conveyance."

WHEREAS it is desired that the property referred to in said deed be conveyed in fee simple to Augusta Heights Baptist Church without said building restrictions and restrictive convenants remaining on the property.

NOW THEREFORE, I, Viola D. Hodgens, hereby release, renounce, and relinquish said restrictions on the property mentioned in the deed referred to above to Augusta Heights Baptist Church, its successors and assigns forever.
