LEASE AGREEMENT

THIS AGREEMENT, made and entered into this 2nd day of March, 1961, by and between GREENVILLE MOTEL CO., INC., a corporation organized and existing under the laws of the State of South Carolina (hereinafter designated as Lessor), and SOUTHERN MORTGAGE INVESTMENT CO., INC. a corporation organized and existing under the laws of the State of South Carolina, (hereinafter designated as Lessee),

WITNESSETH:

The Lessor is lawfully seized of the premises below described, (a) the major portion thereof pursuant to lease agreement dated October 8, 1959 by and between Walter S. Griffin, Jr., as Landlord, and Greenville Motel Co., Inc., as Tenant, as amended by addendum dated March 2, 1961, both the lease and the addendum being recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville County, South Carolina, and (b) the remaining portion thereof pursuant to lease agreement dated March 2, 1961 by and between Southern Mortgage Investment Co., Inc., as Landlord, and Greenville Motel Co., Inc., as Tenant, and recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville County, South Carolina.

NOW, THEREFORE, for and in consideration of the mutual covenants herein contained and of the rental monies to be paid by the Lessee herein to the Lessor herein, the parties hereto do agree as follows:

1. PREMISES: In consideration of the convenants and conditions hereinafter contained and of the rental to be paid by the Lessee, the Lessor does hereby lease and demise unto the Lessee and the Lessee hereby accepts as tenant (for the purpose of operating a motor hotel thereon), the following described premises:
