Glenn, situated on the East side of Cannon Street in the City of Greer, County and State aforesaid, in and across the rear of the adjoining property of the Said D.D. Pitts, Sr., known as the Greer Laundry place, to the dewer line thereon owned by the grantor, with the right to tap said line and connect thereto.

The said T.J. Glenn, or his heirs or assigns, shall have the right to install on his property plumbing fixtures for four standard bathrooms, or other plumbing having a normal discharge equivalent to four bathrooms, and to drain from the same through the grantor's sewer line to the City main sewer.
