ALL that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, in Bates Township, about three miles southwest from the Town of Marietta on the White Horse Road and containing four (4) acres, more or less, and adjoining lands with Sybil Burns on the North and East; lands with S. C. Childs on the South and bounded on the West by White Horse road and having the following courses and distances, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on White Horse road and running thence S. 35 East 664 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 71 West 112 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 33 $\frac{1}{2}$ West 731 feet to an iron pin on White Horse Road; thence with said road, North 31 East 330 feet to the beginning corner.

This is the same property conveyed to Alton E. Anthony and Thelma H. Anthony, by deed of Sybil Burns dated March 24, 1951, recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville County, S. C., in Deed Book 432, page 1. Thereafter the said Alton E. Anthony and Thelma E. Anthony conveyed the said property to J. V. Anthony by deed dated May 31, 1958, recorded in said RMC Office in Deed Book 607, page 13. However, through error in the preparation and the execution of the deed, the said grantor herein, Thelma H. Anthony, did not sign the said deed as a grantor and the purpose of this deed is to quitclaim and release forever any right, title and interest she might have in and to the property described herein.
