## Know All Men by These Presents:

That We, JAMES II. JOYNER and HELEN C. JOYNER

in consideration of the sum of Thirteen Thousand Five Hundred Seventy Seven & 28/160 Dollars and assumption of mortgage referred to below to the grantor(s) in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by the grantee(s) (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said JOHN R. GREGORY, his heirs and assigns, forever:

ALL that lot of land with the buildings and improvements thereon, situate at the Mestern side of Sweetbrier Road (formerly known as Greenbrier Road) near the City of Creenville, in Greenville County, S. C., being shown as Lot No. 50 on plat of Section 2 of Lake Forest Heights, made by Piedmont Engineering Service, May 1957, recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville County, S. C. in Plat Book KK, page 105, and having according to said plat the following metes and bounds, to wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the West side of Sweetbrier Road, at joint front corner of Lots 49 and 50, and runs thence along the line of Lot 49, S. 82-35 W. 149.5 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 4-56 E. 53.6 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 1-25 W. 79.2 feet to an iron pin; thence with the line of Lot 51, N. 81-55 E. 174.8 feet to an iron pin on the West side of Sweetbrier Road; thence with the curve of road (the chord being N. 11-55 W. 130 feet) to the beginning corner.

Grantee assumes and agrees to pay the balance due on that mortgage given by James H. Joyner and Helen C. Joyner to The Prudential Insurance Company of America in the original amount of \$20,000.00 dated March 13, 1959, recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville County, S. C. in Mortgage Book 779, page 148, on which there remains due a principal balance of \$18,922.72.

This is the same property conveyed to the grantors by deed of John S. Taylor, Jr., as Trustee for John S. Taylor, Jr. and R. Reid Tull, dated January 2, 1959, recorded in Deed Book 614, page 202.
