CONTRACT WITH BLUE RIDGE COOPERATIVE, INC., IN THE STATE OF SOUTH CAROLINA, FOR RELOCATION, REARRANGEMENT, OR ALTERATION OF FACILITIES (LUMP SUM)

THIS CONTRACT entered into this 7 th day of August 1961, by and between the UNITED STATES OF AMERICA (hereinafter called the "Government"), represented by the Contracting Officer executing this contract, and BLUE RIDGE ELECTRIC COOPERATIVE, INC., a Corporation organized and existing under the laws of the State of South Carolina, with its principal office and place of business in the City of Pickens, State of South Carolina (hereinafter called the "owner")

: WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, the Government has under authority of Public Law 534,
78th Congress, approved December 22, 1944, and Public Law 516, 31st
Congress, approved May 17, 1950, undertaken the development of the flood
control, hydroelectric and navigation project known as the Hartwell Dam
and Reservoir Project, hereinafter called the Project, and is now engaged
in prosecuting the development of the Project in the State of South
Carolina; and

WHEREAS, the owner is the holder of certain interest in land on which the owner has constructed and is operating and maintaining certain facilities consisting of electric aerial cable and electric aerial wire and associated poles, cross-arms and appliances appurtenant thereto, which interfere with the development and use of the project by the Government; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary in the construction, completion, and enjoyment by the Government of the said project that the aforementioned title, rights and privileges of the owner be abandoned and/or modified and restricted and that certain facilities of the owner be relocated, rearranged or altered; and
