The sum of Two Hundred (\$200.00) Dollars has been paid at the signing of this option and this amount shall be credited on the payment of the purchase price at the time this option is exercised. Should this option not be exercised then this sum will belong to the Seller as the consideration of this option, unless the reason for the non-exercise of the option is the Seller's failure to obtain a divorce or his failure to give good title.

as PLEAS A. BUTLER obtains a good and valid divorce from his present wife he shall give to H. B. GOSNELL notice that said divorce has been obtained. After such notice has been given to H. B. GOSNELL, H. B. GOSNELL shall have thirty (30) days within which to exercise this option by payment of the purchase price, unless the duration of this option may be shortened by this notice, this option shall last for a period of one year. This option shall be exercised by payment of the purchase price.

Upon payment of the purchase price the Seller agrees to convey to the Buyer a good and marketable fee simple title, free
