Know All Men by These Presents:

That I, Jeanette D. Boldt, in the State aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of Five and No/100-----(\$5.00)-----DOLLARS, and love and affection for my daughter (see below) to the grantor(s) in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by the grantee(s) (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Lynda Boldt Waldrep, her heirs and assigns forever:

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land in Paris Mountain Township, Greenville County, South Carolina, and containing 1.69 acres, more or less, and located on the southeastern side of N. Parker Road and being shown and designated as Lot #2 on a recent survey of property of Jeanette J. Boldt, prepared by Dalton & Neves dated March, 1963, a copy of said plat being recorded herewith and according to said plat having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at a point on the southeastern side of N. Parker Road, being the joint corner of Lot #2 and property of E. P. Castle and running thence with the Castle line S. 78-40 E. 491 feet to a stake on Poor House Creek; thence with said creek N. 3-03 E. 59 feet; thence continuing with said creek N. 24-11 E. 88 feet to a point in said Poor House Creek, being the joint rear corner of Lots 1 and 2 of Jeanette J. Boldt property; thence with the joint line of said property, N. 80-09 W. 528.1 feet to an iron pin on the southeastern side of N. Parker Road; thence with said N. Parker Road S. 0-15 W. 133.95 feet to the beginning corner, this being a portion of the property conveyed to Herman D. Boldt and Jeanette D. Boldt by deed recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Deed Volume 309 at Page 117. The interest of Herman D. Boldt, deceased, merged into Jeanette D. Boldt by deed from Shirley Boldt Makara, Lynda Boldt Waldrep, and Carole Boldt Townsend, the Grantor herein, Jeanette D. Boldt, being the widow of Herman D. Boldt, deceased.

It being a part of the consideration for this deed that the Grantee herein, Lynda Boldt Waldrep, agrees that in the event she ever desires to convey the within described property, she will first give her two sisters the right of refusal to purchase it at the then going price.

And the grantor(s) do(es) hereby bind the grantor(s) and the grantor's(s) Heirs, Executors and Administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the grantee(s) hereinabove named, and the grantee's(s) Heirs and Assigns against the grantor(s) and the grantor's(s) Heirs and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
