


BEGINNING at an iron pin on the northern side of Notre Dame Drive at the joint corner of Lots 19 and 21 and running thence with Notre Dame Drive, N. 42-48 E. 107.4 feet to a point; thence continuing with said drive, N. 48-30 E. 75 feet to a point; thence continuing with said drive, N. 49-38 E. 80 feet to a point; thence continuing with said drive as it intersects with Tulane Drive, following the curvature thereof, the chord of which is N. 05-19 E. 35.8 feet to an iron pin on the southwestern side of Tulane Avenue; thence with said avenue, N. 39-0 W. 70 feet to a point; thence continuing with said avenue, N. 42-58 W. 75 feet to an iron pin, joint front corner of Lots 19 and 20; thence with the joint line of said lots, S. 34-29 W. 286.6 feet to an iron pin in the line of Lot 21; thence with the line of Lot 21, S. 35-48 E. 110 feet to the beginning corner; being the same conveyed to me by B.
