Eckford, Gulf Oil Corp., and Butler Avenue, and having according to said plat the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the easterly side of Butler Avenue in line of property now or formerly of Gulf Oil Corp. and running thence along the line of said property, S. 64-10 E. 53 feet to a point; thence turning and running s. 3-00 W. 8 feet to a point; thence along the line of property now or formerly of Ted E. Eckford, S. 62-52 E. 37.2 feet to an iron pin; thence turning and running S. 30-46 W. 57 feet to old iron pin in line of property now or formerly of Hunt Estate; thence turning and running along line of property now or formerly of Hunt Estate, N. 69-10 W. 83.7 feet to an iron pin on easterly side of Butler Avenue; thence turning and running along the easterly side of Butler Avenue, N. 21-23 E. 72.3 feet to an iron pin, the point of beginning.


