to the main trunk lines of Greater Greenville Sewer District
Commission would be constructed at no expense to Greater Greenville Sewer District and providing further that such construction was to be under the supervision of the Superintendent of
the Greater Greenville Sewer District and the Engineer for
Gantt Water and Sewer District and should be subject to all
the rules, regulations and requirements of Greater Greenville
Sewer District Commission. Said Petition further provides
that the sewer lines when constructed will be deeded to Gantt
Water and Sewer District without expense to said District and
will be maintained by Gantt Water and Sewer District, and
Gantt Water and Sewer District has expressly agreed to maintain
such lines at the expense of Gantt and in accordance with accepted
sewerage practices and the rules and regulations of the Greater
Greenville Sewer District Commission.

After review of such Petition and of the facts existing, the Greater Greenville Sewer District Commission has now determined that it is to the interests of the Greater Greenville Sewer District Commission to act favorably upon said Petition and to incorporate the area described above into Greater Greenville Sewer District. Greater Greenville Sewer District Commission is further satisfied that there are no qualified electors residing in the area described above, that the entire property described above is owned by R. E. Hughes, and that the Petition submitted was signed by all the freeholders in the area involved.

Greater Greenville Sewer District Commission, therefore, approves the Petition of R. E. Hughes and the agreement of Gantt Water and Sewer District Commission and does hereby annex to and incorporate into Greater Greenville Sewer District the property described above and from this date forth all such
