

County, State of South Carolina , about five miles North of Greer, lying on the Southern side of a community road that leads off State Highway # 14, and being part of the same land that was conveyed to Myra Pittman Wolfe, by deed from T. L. & Beulah F. Forrester, January 11th, 1947, recorded in the Office of R. M. C. for Greenville County in Deed Book 306 at page 14, and having the following courses and distances, to-wit:

BEGINNING on a stake in the said community road, joint corner of the lot being conveyed by Myra Pittman Wolfe July 8, 1958, to James A. Howard, and runs thence with the common line of the said two lots, S. 26-00 E. 20 feet to an iron pin on the southern bank of the said road; thence continuing with the same course for a total distance of 217 feet to iron pin; thence S. 63-55 W. 100 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 26-00 W. 217 feet to a stake in the said community road (iron pin back on line at 21 feet); thence with the said road, N. 63-55 E. 100 feet to the beginning corner, containing one half (1/2) acre, more or less.

This is the same property conveyed to us by deed from Joan B. Howard, recorded in the R. MC. Office for Greenville County in Deed Book 700, at page 134.
