in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, containing sixty-eight (68) acres, more or less, as shown on plat of a survey made by Hugh J. Martin, surveyor, dated May 8, 1962, recorded in the records of Greenville County, South Carolina, in Plat Book EEE ___, page __167 _. According to said plat, property is described as follows:
