WITNESSETH:

That Grantor, in consideration of \$750.00 paid by Grantee, the receipt of which is hereby ocknowledged, does grant and convey unto Grantee, its successors and assigns, the right to erect, construct, reconstruct, replace, maintain and use towers, poles, wires, lines, cables, and all necessary and proper foundations, footings, crossarms and other appliances and fixtures for the purpose of transmitting electric power and for Grantee's communication purposes, together with a right of way, on, along and in all of the hereinafter described tract(s) of land lying and being in Greenville County, South Carolina, and more particularly described as follows:

a surveyed line which has been marked on the ground and extends from a point in the northeasterly line of the J. T. Styles property, said point being N 28-28 W 489.4 ft. from the southerly corner of the property of the Grantor and runs thence S 71-33 E 624.2 ft.; thence S 30-03 E 4.0 ft. to the westerly corner of the Malvin Green property.
