8. The general nature of the business for which the corporation is organized is (it is not necessary to set forth in the purposes powers enumerated in Section 2.2) (12—12.2 Supplemental Code 1962)

Buy, sell, exchange, develop and improve real estate and personal property, to erect buildings, to lease and manage real estate, and do all things incident to the ownership and development of real estate.
