WHEREAS, by Summons and Complaint dated the 16th day of September, 1964, the plaintiff in the above entitled matter brought an action against the South Carolina State Highway Department claiming water damage to certain personal property situate in his store known as "The Little Beach", on the Mauldin (Old Parkins Mill) Road in the County and State aforesaid and to his real estate, a portion of which is described in the Complaint and which was conveyed to him by Calvin T. Fowler by deed dated April 5, 1956, recorded in Deed Book 552 at Page 426, said property being further designated on the Greater Greenville Block Book as 423-1-3.1. In fact, the above property is situate on the South side of said road and the property on which said store building is situate is property on the northerly side of said road containing 4.10 acres, more or less, designated on the Greater Greenville Block Book as Ml2.1-1-3 and being identically the same property conveyed to Frank James Fowler by Calvin T. Fowler by deed dated October 9, 1949, recorded in Deed Book 393 at page 308;

WHEREAS, it is alleged that said damages occured by reason of the improvement and relocation of said Mauldin Road about the year 1954, the greatest damage allegedly occuring during March of 1964; and whereas said parties have agreed upon a settlement on said claim for damages in the amount of Three Thousand and no/100 (\$3000.00) Dollars, liability for which is specifically denied but said settlement agreed upon to terminate a contested claim.
