

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with the buildings and improvements thereon, lying and being on the northerly side of Butternut Drive, near the City of Greenville, S. C., being known and designated as Lot No. 9 on plat of Chestnut Hills, as recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville County, S. C. in Plat Book GG, at page 35, and having according to said plat the following metes and bounds, to-wit:
