All that piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being on the Southeastern side of Hampton Avenue in the City of Greenville, County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, being the Northwestern portion of the Property of Nannie J. Galloway and M.A. Galloway, as shown on a plat prepared by C.M. Furman, Jr., C.E., dated February 12, 1926, recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, South Carolina, in Plat Book G at page 145, and having according to said plat the following metes and bounds:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the Southeastern side of Hampton Avenue, which iron pin is located N. 49-00 W. 157.5 feet from the intersection of Hampton Avenue and North Hudson Street, and running thence with the Southeastern side of Hampton Avenue N. 49 W. 50 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 34-33 W. 177.3 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 49-00 E. 50 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 34-33 E. 178 feet, more or less, to the point of beginning.
