It would appear from the deed that this assumption agreement was inserted after the deed had originally been prepared but before it was executed. In any event, as Attorney for R. E. ¡Phillips, Jr., I did pay to Fidelity Federal Savings & Loan Association the sum of \$2400.00 in consideration of which Fidelity Federal Savings & Loan Association executed the release releasing the property from its mortgage. Of course, this payment of \$2400.00 more than satisfied any obligation imposed by the deed to pay \$1500.00 and there is no obligation of R. E. Phillips, Jr. to pay any part of the remaining balance due to Fidelity FEderal Sayings & Loan Association.
