BEGINNING at an iron pin on the eastern edge of Chick Springs Road, joint front corner of Lots 3 and 4 and running thence along the joint line of said lots, S. 61-02 E. 356.5 feet to a point on the margin of a lake, the joint rear corner of said lots; thence along the margin of said lake, a traverse line being N. 42-53 E. 80.0 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 40-46 W. 256.0 feet to an iron pin on the southern edge of Stono Drive; thence along the southern edge of Stono Drive, following the curvature thereof, the chords being N. 85-02 W. 105.0 feet and N. 77-18 W. 45.0 feet to an iron pin; thence around the curvature of the intersection of Stono Drive with Chick Springs Road, the chord being S. 59-56 W. 36.6 feet to an iron pin on the eastern edge of Chick Springs Road; thence along the eastern edge of Chick Springs Road, following the curvature thereof, the chord being S. 17-10 W. 65 feet to the beginning corner.

This conveyance is subject to recorded easements and rights-of-way for the installation and maintenance of public utilities, including a right-of-way for a water main and sanitary sewer as shown on the plats aforementioned; and there is also imposed upon the above described lot restrictions and protective covenants identical to those recorded in the R.
