released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto
John T. Langston, Sr. and John T. Langston, Jr., their Heirs and Assigns forever:
ALL that piece, parcel or lot of land in Fairview Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina. Town of Fountain Inn, on the eastern side of South Main Street, in accordance with a plat made for Garrett and Garrett by Carolina Engineering Service and dated January 15th, 196 and beingmore fully described in accordance with said plat, to-wit:
BEGINNING at an iron pin on the eastern side of South Main Street, 35 feet from a 9 foot sidewalk, being the property line of the Grantor and running thence N. 51-20 E. 131.6 feet to a point; thence N. 52-46 E. 132 feet to an iron pin on edge of Weston Street; thence along the edge of Weston Street S. 38-0 E. 35 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 52-46 W. 131.6 feet to an iron pin on edge of South Main Street; thence along South Main Street N. 37-52 W. 35 feet to an iron pin, being the point of beginning.

It is/further proviso and condition of this conveyance that the Grantees shall have an equal interest in the party wall as shown on the above referred to plat and as designated in the description, provided the grantees pay to Blake P. Garrett, Louise Y. Garrett, David H. Garrett, Mary Lou Garrett, George P. Wenck and Annie Mae W. Wenck the sum of \$450.00 at the time Grantees desire to use same.
