DECREE OF DIVORCE

Now comes the Plaintiff, and the Defendant having been duly served by publication and having failed to appear, the Courtfinds Defendant in default for answer and demurrer to said petition, and finds that the allegations thereof are confessed by Defendant to be true. The Court also finds that the Plaintiff, at the time of filing her petition, had been a resident of the State of Ohio for one year next preceding the same, and was at that time a bona fide resident of Franklin County, and had resided in Franklin County more than 90 days immediately preceding the filing of her petition, and that the parties hereto were married, as in said petition set forth. The Court further finds, upon the evidence adduced that the Defendant has been guilty of gross neglect of duty and extreme cruelty and that by reason thereof, the Plaintiff is entitled to a divorce as prayed for in her Petition.

It is therefore ordered and adjudged by the Court, that the marriage contract heretofore existing between the said Johnnie McCuen and Richard P. McCuen be, and the same hereby is dissolved and both parties are released from the obligations of the same.

It is ORDERED AND DECREED that the question of child support is held in abeyance until such time as personal service is had upon the Defendant, and that the Plaintiff is hereby awarded sole and exclusive custody of the children of the parties hereto.
