

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Cleveland County State of South Carolina, on the South Fork of Saluda River, about 22 miles from the Greenville County Courthouse, near Blythe Shoals, and having the following metes and bounds, according to survey and plat thereof made by E. C. Edens, Surveyor, October 16, 1918, to-wit:

BEGINNING at Seven-Bark tree 3xn on the south side of the South Fork of Saluda River, corner of Hawkins land, and running thence along the Hawkins line S. 83-1/2 E. 54.40 chains to a rock on a road 3xn; thence N. 61-1/4 E. 29.65 chains to a White Oak 3XN; thence N. 27 W. 8.40 chains to a Pine Tree; thence N. 19 E. 11.50 chains to a stake 3XN on bank of a road; thence N. 38-3/4 W. 12.60 chains to a Hickory tree; thence N. 63-1/2 W. 13.25 chains to a rock 3XN, in line of property now or formerly of McGee; thence S. 52-1/2 W. 16.50 chains along McGee's line to a stake in a road; thence with said road S. 22-1/2 E. 2.25 chains to bend in said road; thence S. 10 E. 4.80 chains to bend in said road; thence S. 67 E. 4.45 chains to a rock near the fork of the road, corner of property now or formerly of Bates; thence S. 79 W. 8.54 chains to a pine stump on the Pumpkintown Road; thence N. 86 W. 9.86 chains to Ash tree 3XO on the South Fork of Saluda River; thence down said river following the meanders thereof as the line to the beginning corner, and containing 181 acres, more or less, and the beginning corner, and containing 181 acres, more or less, and adjoining lands now or formerly of Hawkins, McGee et al.
