- 7. Upon the payment in full of all indebtedness secured hereby this Assignment of Rents and Leases shall become and be void and of no effect, and a reconveyance of the Trust Deed or release of the Mortgage securing said indebtedness shall automatically constitute a reassignment of the rents and leases assigned hereby without further act upon the part of Assignee or any successor in interest of Assignee.
- 8. This Assignment applies to, inures to the benefit of and binds all parties hereto, their heirs, legatees, devisees, administrators, executors, successors and assigns. Whenever the term "Assignor" is used herein, such reference shall be deemed to mean each Assignor whose name appears below, severally, and all such Assignors, jointly and severally and their respective heirs, legatees, devisees, executors, successors and assigns. Whenever the term "Assignee" is used herein, such term shall include all successors and assigns of the Assignee named herein.
