vest in the Trustor and the remaindermen who may take at the death of the Trustor vested rights under the terms hereof, but with said Trustee in no event bound by any of the provisions hereof for the payment of any funds or the performance of any duties with respect to trust property until it shall have actually received such trust property, with the right of resignation vested in said Trustee to in no sense modify or affect the immediate effectiveness of this trust agreement, and with the obligations assumed by said Trustee to at all times be limited and restricted to the extent of funds belonging to said trust available in its hands for its use.
