All that piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in Butler Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, being known and designated as the major portion of Lot 23 of Rolling Green Real Estate Co. as shown on plat thereof recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville County in Plat Book XX, Page 33, and being more particularly described according to a plat entitled "Revision of Lots Nos. 23 and 24, Rolling Green Real Estate Co." prepared by F. Webb dated June 22, 1966, and recorded in Plat Book PPP, Page 14, as follows:
